- Employment of nationals
- When a foreign company makes products in a country, the materials, parts etc. that have been made in that country rather than imported

Different Scenarios of Local Content

- Total indigenous company – 100% Nigerian Owned and staffed
- Partially indigenous company – greater than 50% Nigerian Owned and staffed
- Foreign Company – 100% foreign owned but 100% local staffed
- Total indigenous company but 100% foreign products
- Foreign Company but greater than 50% local products
