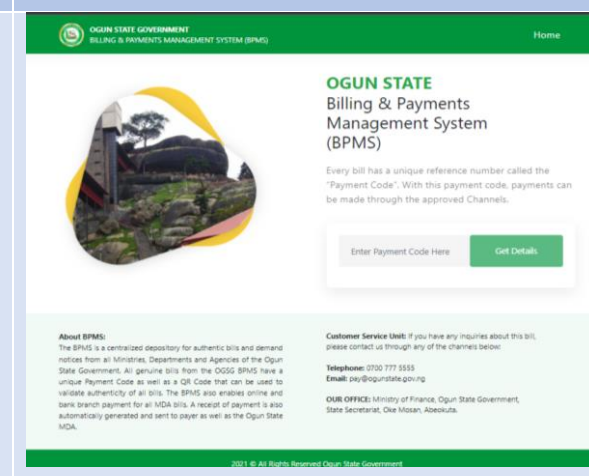
## OGUN STATE LAND ADMINISTRATION & REVENUE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (OLARMS) PORTAL

## OGUN STATE BILLING AND PAYMENTS MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (BPMS)

The BPMS is a centralized depository for authentic bills and demand notices from all Ministries, Departments and Agencies of the Ogun State Government. All genuine bills from the OGSG BPMS have a unique Payment Code as well as a QR Code that can be used to validate authenticity of all bills. The BPMS also enables online and bank branch payment for all MDA bills. A receipt of payment is also automatically generated and sent to payer as well as the Ogun State MDA

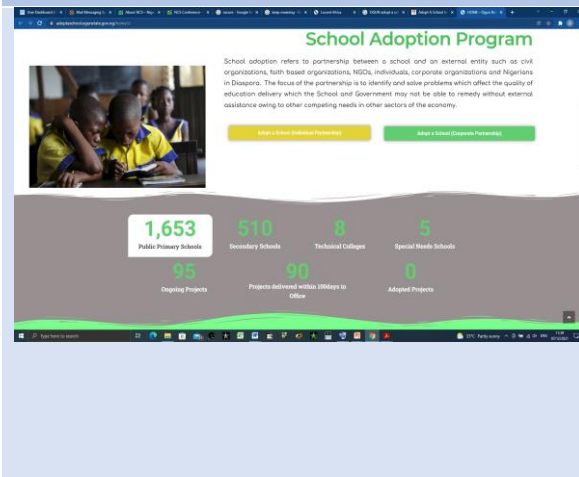
## VIRTUAL COURT

## OGUN ADOPT A SCHOOL PROJECT

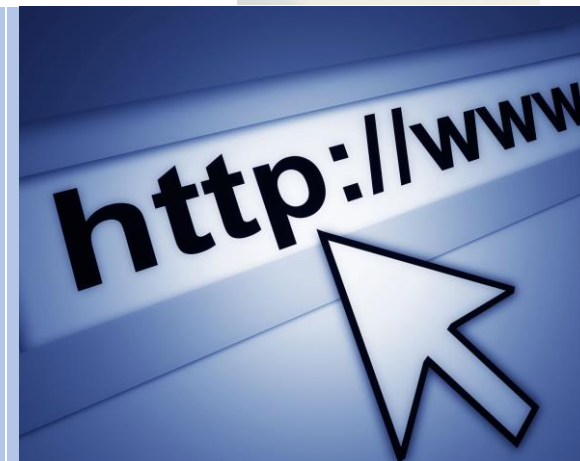
